


Multiple farm Walk

Isle Walk Purbeck presents - a scenic route encompassing several Purbeck farm settlements, count them as you go...

*this walk is dog friendly but please put on lead when livestock is grazing and be aware the route includes crossing roads and railway lines



Park close to the houses at New Barn just north of the railway bridge. Turn right at the footpath sign, just opposite the old wood shed, towards the stile next to the gate.

Dist to next: 0.02mi

2. Climb over the stile SZ 0023 7977

Turn left and follow the footpath along the western edge of the field. Dist to next: 0.30mi

3. Climb over the stile at the top of the field SZ 0049

Wiggle through the metal barrier and head straight on towards Knitson Farm.

Dist to next: 0.28mi

4. Walk through the farm SZ 0056 8061

Keep the farm buildings to your left.

Dist to next: 0.04mi

5. Turn left when you reach the road SZ 0056 8068

Follow the road between Knitson Farm on your left and Dairy Cottage on your right

Dist to next: 0.04mi

6. Turn right at Knitson Old farmhouse SZ 0053 8072

Follow the track past Knitson Old Farmhouse, which will be on your left. Walk past the two other houses on your left, and head for the gate at the top of the track

Dist to next: 0.11mi

7. Turn left through the gate SZ 0052 8090

Go straight through another gate and follow the underhill path on the left. Keep following this path until you reach the Under Hill Road sign, and a gate on your left.

WARNING: This path can be very muddy above Knaveswell Farm, where there is a natural spring. To avoid this you can continue on the road at Knitson Farm, until you get to Ricketts Farm - but this will probably only be necessary when it has been wet weather.

Dist to next: 0.63mi

8. Turn left at the gate at the sign to the Under Hill Road SY 9958 8125 Follow the track down to the road

Dist to next: 0.07mi

9. This is Ricketts Farm, take the gate to the right of the old barn on the opposite side of the road, signed to New Buildings and Langton. Dist to next: 0.01mi

10. Go through the gate SY 9953 8115 Continue through the farm buildings into an open field

Dist to next: 0.35mi,

11. Continue through the field SY 9949 8061

Keep to the left of the fence in the middle of the field and follow it to a gate. Bear right into a rough patch of land. Go over a small stream and onto the next field ahead of you.

Dist to next: 0.05mi





Multiple Farm Walk

12. Go through a gate and turn left into the next field SY 9943 8059

Follow the hedge on your left.

WARNING: it can be very swampy here as you navigate your way over

another small stream Dist to next: 0.17mi

13. Climb over the stile/ gate SY 9954 8033 Follow the footpath on the right side of the field

Dist to next: 0.13mi

14. Climb over stile to right of the house SY 99518021 Follow the narrow path between two hedges that brings you out at

main road, with BP St Michael's garage on your right.



Aim for the gate to the left of the house on the opposite side of the

road

Dist to next: 0.01mi

16. Go through the gate, signed footpath to Langton SY 9948 8012

Take the path right next to the house, walking through the garden into

the woodland

Dist to next: 0.14mi

17. At next stile, cross the railway line SY 9940 7992

There is no level crossing so take care to look left and right before

crossing. There are steps and another stile on the other side.

Dist to next: 0.09mi



18. Walk through the woodland SY 9939 7978

Emerge on the other side of the trees and climb over stile into an open field.

Walk uphill through the field until you reach a stile at the top.

Dist to next: 0.09mi

19. Go over the stile, turn left SY 9938 7963

Follow the path through the tress, back to the main road

Dist to next: 0.34mi

20. Cross the road SY 9994 7962

Walk down the lane, under the railway bridge and back to New Barn Farm

Dist to next: 0.19mi

21. Finish SZ 0019 7977
