

The Agglestone and Greenlands Farm

The Agglestone appears from nowhere in this sandy heathland close to Studland Bay. This walk is a gentle stroll through the gorse and heather to explore this dramatic sandstone rock and enjoy the distant views towards Poole Harbour and the sea.

*the walk is dog friendly but please keep on lead near livestock

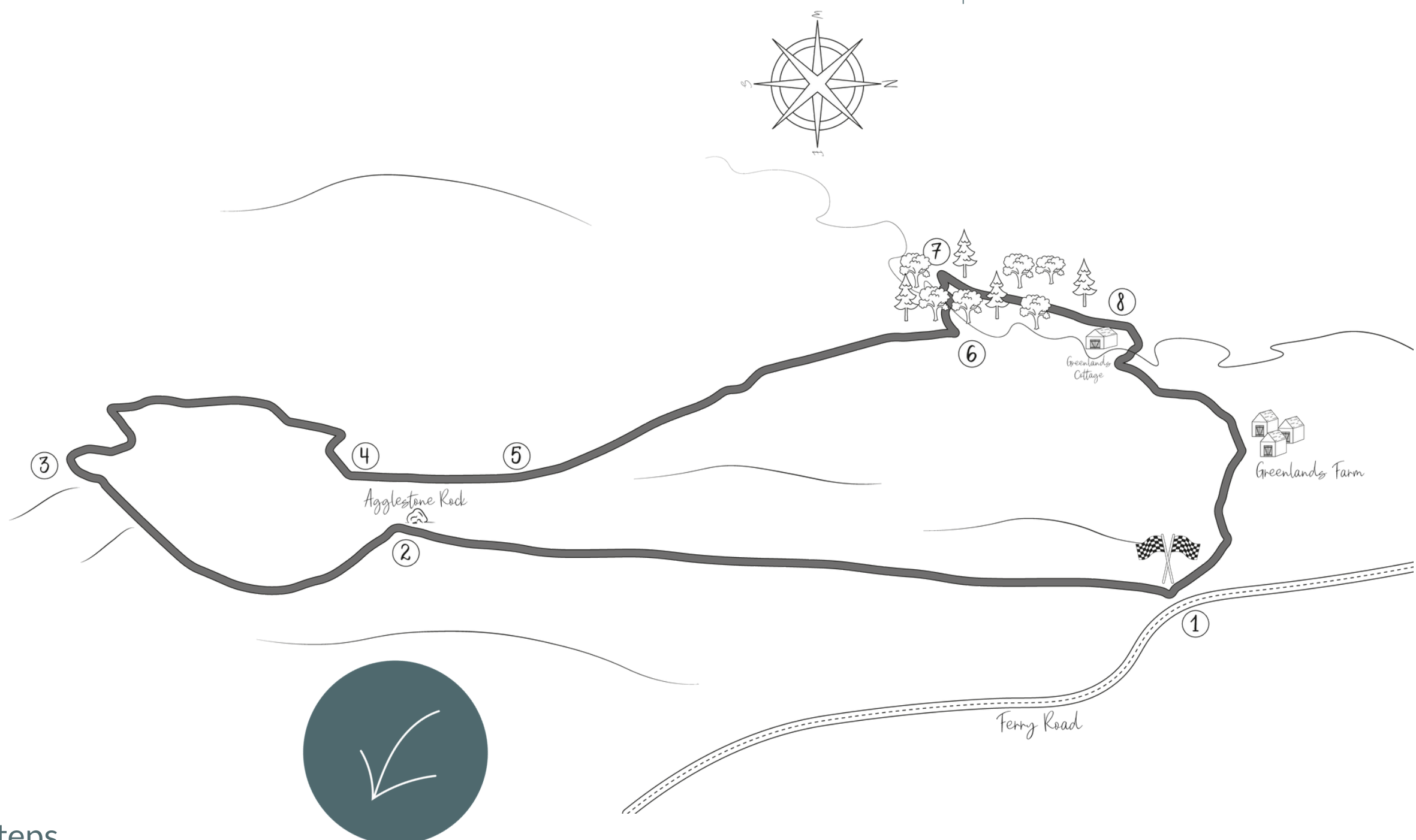

The Basic Steps

1. Start on the Ferry Road SZ 0252 8431

2. Park at the sign to Godlingston Heath. Take the path on the left towards the Agglestone.

Dist to next: 0.66mi

3. Bear left SZ 0245 8327

Keep the Agglestone in view and follow the path until you reach the rock

Dist to next: 0.45mi

4. From the rock follow path to right SZ 0228 8275

Dist to next: 0.50mi

5. Turn left SZ 0228 8318

Dist to next: 0.17mi

6. Follow the main track SZ 0225 8344

Keep walking towards Greenland Farm

Dist to next: 0.64mi

7. Turn left SZ 0158 8419

Follow the path through the woodland

Dist to next: 0.18mi

8. Turn right SZ 0128 842

Dist to next: 0.25mi

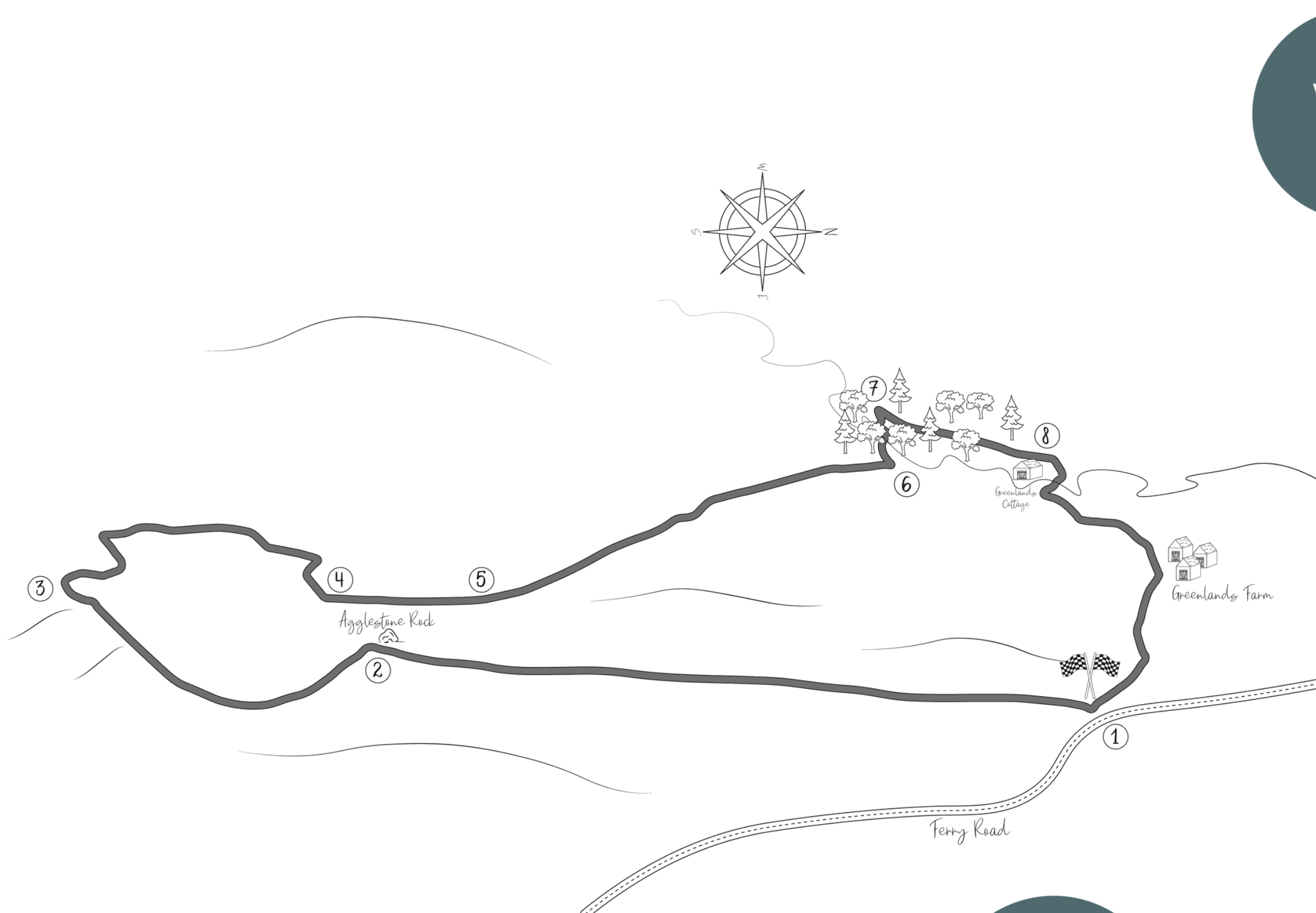
9. Turn Right SZ 0152 8452

Follow the path past the farm house and back to the ferry road

Dist to next: 0.71mi

10. Finish at Ferry Road SZ 0252 8433
